Overview of the Websites

Established in April 2012

Website of the Communications Authority (CA)



- Mainly provides information and documents in connection with the roles and regulatory functions of the CA
- Such as statements, decisions, codes of practice, consultation papers and licensing documents issued by the CA

Website of the Office of the Communications Authority (OFCA)



- Mainly provides information and documents in connection with the operation of OFCA
- Such as consumer alerts, statistics, information on spectrum auctions and documents on technical
 standards

Overview of the Websites

Through the websites of the CA and OFCA, you can...

- search for information about the CA and OFCA, such as announcements, statements issued and also the latest communications market statistics
- apply for licences, certificates and permits online
- check the information of telecommunications service licensees and their services provided
- search for registered Wi-Fi hotspots
- enquire about the digital TV coverage areas
- know about the fibre network connection status of a building
- know about the mobile network coverage of hiking trails in country parks
- lodge a complaint or report a case
- subscribe to the online newsletter to receive news from the CA/OFCA



Objectives of the Website Revamp

- Comply with the latest website design requirements laid down by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer (OGCIO)
- Improve the websites' web accessibility designs, making them more user-friendly, easier to search for information, more efficient to maintain
- Renew the designs of the websites to enhance CA's and OFCA's corporate images



OGCIO's requirements on website designs

- Government websites should adopt Responsive Web Design (RWD) by end of 2020
- RWD can automatically detect the screen size of a browsing device (such as PC, mobile phone, tablet); enabling webpages to be displayed with the best viewing effect

Proposed Changes

Improve Website Design

- Remove Adobe Flash animations in the websites - technical support to Adobe Flash will end soon
- Improve websites' colour contrast to fully comply with the web accessibility requirements
- Enhance website structures easier to browse and search for information

Proposed Changes

Remove Regulator Archives

- i.e. websites of the former Broadcasting Authority and Office of the Telecommunications Authority
- The websites are retained to facilitate the public to search for reference information, in particular during the early establishments of the CA and OFCA
- Most of the content is already outdated or invalid
- Suggest removing the Regulator Archives and migrating the documents that need to be kept to the OFCA website
