Implementation Timetable of Real-name Registration for SIM Cards

The Telecommunications (Registration of SIM Cards) Regulation ("Regulation") took effect on 1 September 2021

Issued before 1 March 2022 Issued from 1 March 2022 onwards **Existing SIM Card Newly Issued SIM Card** Must complete real name registration ("RNR") Pre paid **SIM Service** before service activation SIM ("PPS") Plan ("SSP") Card Card The Regulation 1 March 2022 **23 February 2023** took effect on 1 September 2021 Need to complete RNR within the registration period



No need to re-register (unless they change to another service provider or subscribe to a new phone number)

Latest Progress on Registration of PPS Cards

(As at 4 December 2022)

Existing PPS Cards (Issued before 1 March 2022)

- More than 920K existing PPS cards have already completed RNR
- About 16% of all activated
 PPS cards



- **1.54M** new PPS cards have been issued
- All newly issued PPS cards have completed RNR before service activation





Registration Channels



Information Required for RNR



Individual User

(Register not more than 10[#] PPS cards with each telecommunications service provider)

Name in English and Chinese

Identification Document Number*

Copy of Identification Document

Date of Birth



User aged below 16: requires endorsement by an adult aged 18 or above, and personal information of that adult need to be registered



Corporate User

(Register not more than 25" PPS cards with each telecommunications service provider)

Name of the Business

Number of Business / Branch Registration Certificate

Copy of Business / Branch Registration Certificate

Personal Information of Responsible Person

- * If user possesses a HKID card, he/she must use his/her HKID card for registration
- * Visitor shall use travel document for registration # No limit on the number of registrable SSP cards

Points to Note for PPS Card Users



Unregistered existing PPS cards cannot be used after 23 February 2023



Some telecommunications service providers may require users to complete registration before the deadline



Some telecommunications service providers may stop the provision of service to unregistered PPS cards in advance

In order to avoid any service impact, existing PPS card users should complete registration as soon as possible



SMS Messages Sent by Telecommunications Service Providers on RNR

(Brand name) (Serial number): Please complete the realname registration of the pre-paid SIM card (Mobile number/ICCID) at https://www...... on or before 23/02/2023. Enquiry: (Hotline of telecommunications service provider)

- Telecommunications service providers have sent notifications via SMS messages by using the designated sender address "SIMREG" to existing PPS card users reminding them to complete RNR by following the instructions provided in the SMS
- Telecommunications service providers will send final SMS notification reminders to the users concerned in January and February 2023 respectively. The SMS message will include:
 - Details of the telecommunications service provider
 - > Relevant registration channels
 - Mobile number of the PPS card
