



Migration of Six Digital TV Programme Channels to New Transmitting Frequencies

住戶須知

Notes for Residents



From 1 December 2021, 00:00 onwards, the following six digital TV programme channels will be migrated to new transmitting frequencies. The six digital TV programme channels will simultaneously broadcast on both the existing and new transmitting frequencies from 1 April to 30 November this year (Digital Simulcast).

How to continue to receive these six digital TV programme channels?



Public Housing Estates


- The Housing Authority or the Housing Society will arrange for the reconfiguration of the common antenna broadcast distribution (CABD) systems.
- Residents should pay attention to building management notifications of whether and when they need to rescan the digital TV programme channels on their TV sets or digital terrestrial television (DTT) receivers.





Private Residential Estates / Buildings / Housing Courts of Various Subsidised Home Ownership Schemes

- Residents generally receive TV signals using CABD systems of their buildings. Responsible parties of the CABD systems should engage contractors to reconfigure the systems within the Digital Simulcast period.
- Residents should pay attention to building management notifications of whether and when they need to rescan the digital TV programme channels on their TV sets or DTT receivers.



Village Houses / Bungalows / Old Tenement Buildings or Three-nil Buildings without CABD Systems

- Residents generally receive TV signals using self-provided antennae (commonly known as "fishbone antennae").
- If residents cannot receive any of the above digital TV programme channels after 1 December 2021, 00:00, please rescan the digital TV programme channels on their TV sets or DTT receivers.



Points to note for "three-nil buildings" residents

"Three-nil buildings" refer to buildings without incorporated owners, residents' organisations and building management offices. For those three-nil buildings or old tenement buildings installed with **CABD systems**, residents should engage contractors to reconfigure the systems within the Digital Simulcast period, and check with the contractors whether and when they need to rescan the digital TV programme channels on their TV sets or DTT receivers.

Please refer to the user manuals of TV sets / DTT receivers for the procedures to rescan the digital TV programme channels or consult the equipment supplier directly. You may also visit the thematic webpage set up on the Office of the Communications Authority (OFCA)'s website for step-by-step instructions or video clips on how to rescan the digital TV programme channels on major brands of TV sets / DTT receivers.

這次轉用新發射頻率只會涉及上述六個數碼電視節目台,不會影響其他數碼電視節目台: J2台82、無綫新聞台83、明珠台84及無綫財經·資訊台85,以及香港國際財經台76及香港開電視77(如目前已能接收這些節目台)。

The migration to new transmitting frequencies will only involve the above six digital TV programme channels, and will not affect other digital TV programme channels: J2 82, TVB News 83, Pearl 84 and TVB Finance & Information 85, as well as Hong Kong International Business Channel 76 and Hong Kong Open TV 77 (if currently already receivable).
