Sorry for taking this to you so late, as we needed more time to consult our members. Although it is now well past the deadline, we'd appreciate if you could take these opinions into consideration.

HKISPA and her members, to their interests, collectively believe that,

- 1. BWA licenses should be open to all service providers and should not be limited to existing FTNS operators.
- 2. BWA as replacement of last-mile access and as blackhual applications should be seperately treated.
- 3. Specifically, we welcome the possibility of new players coming to the market using BWA to replace the last-mile access, as a stimulant to the last-mile access competition.
- 4. Mobility and roaming should be covered in the new BWA license, as it is anticipated that mobility capability should be widely available in forthcoming equipments when BWA can be deployed in Hong Kong.
- 5. As for the issue of assignment of frequency spectrum, our members advocate a beauty contest approach for a fairer playing ground between smaller players and big players.
