### **Agenda Item 1: Matters Arising**

Item 3 of the 23rd SSAC Meeting (Proposed Revision to HKCA 2001 Compliance Test Specification for Safety and Electrical Protection Requirements for Subscriber Telecommunications Equipment)

1. <u>The Secretary</u> reported that the revised HKCA 2001 specification was adopted and posted on OFCA's website in December 2020.

# Agenda Item 2: Consultancy Study on Non-ionising Radiation Safety of Radio Base Stations (SSAC Paper No. 1/2021)

- 2. <u>Mr Eric Wong</u> presented SSAC Paper No. 1/2021 concerning the conduction of a consultancy study on non-ionising radiation ("NIR") safety of radio base stations ("RBS") by OFCA.
- 3. The Chairman said that the consultancy study was an initiative of OFCA for engaging a consultant to review the existing measures and make recommendations on practical new measures for controlling NIR safety of RBS so as to facilitate the on-going development of public mobile services in Hong Kong. Upon completion of the consultancy study, OFCA would arrange for the consultant to brief Members on its findings and recommendations.

# Agenda Item 3: Type Acceptance Criteria for 5G Radio Equipment Certification (SSAC Paper No. 2/2021)

4. <u>Mr Charles Chow</u> presented SSAC Paper No. 2/2021 concerning type

acceptance criteria for certification of 5G radio equipment.

5. Mr Carlson Chu asked why TAC 011 did not cover active antenna system ("AAS") for base station equipment operating in the millimetre wave ("mmWave") bands. Mr Charles Chow replied that TAC 011 covered only AAS for multi-standard base station equipment operating in sub-6 GHz band. The Chairman added that OFCA issued type acceptance criteria in response to operators' request to facilitate their deployment of equipment for timely launch of new services, such as 5G services, though there was no applicable HKCA specification at the relevant time. If operators had any such need, they could approach OFCA accordingly. As soon as an applicable widely recognised standard emerged, OFCA would consult Members for adoption in a new HKCA specification to supersede the type acceptance criteria concerned.

[Post-meeting note: Single-standard 5G AAS base station equipment operating in the 24.25 - 28.35 GHz band is covered by TAC 005.]

## **Agenda Item 4:** World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly 2020 (SSAC Paper No. 3/2021)

- 6. <u>Mr Jack Yip</u> presented SSAC Paper 3/2021 and gave an overview of the World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly ("WTSA") 2020.
- 7. The Chairman said that the International Telecommuication Union convened WTSA and World Radiocommunication Conference for worldwide harmonisation on telecommunications standards and frequency spectrum allocation respectively. As in the past, OFCA would consider joining the Mainland delegation team to attend WTSA 2020 to be held in 2022 in India to keep abreast of the latest development and timely update Members on the matters accordingly.
